Ann Macgregor has worked with Minnesota Valley Action Council (MVAC) for 19 years in the Housing Department. She has coordinated the Homeless programs as well as managing the 138 rental properties for Minnesota Affordable and Accessible Housing. Her current title is Underwriter, where she underwrites the Home Improvement loans for Minnesota Housing and the Small Cities loans for the Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED).

For the past 12 years, Ann has coordinated the Family Assets for Independence in Minnesota (FAIM) program for MVAC and is serving on the statewide council for the program. The program is a two year Individual Development Account program where the participant saves \$40 a month and has that money matched at a 3:1 rate. Ann work's with the client during these two years to help them not only to build a savings account, but teach financial fitness techniques, work on improving their credit, and set them up with classes towards their goal in this program. The three goals that a participant can work towards are starting or expanding a small business, go back to school, or purchase a home.
